Minutes of the 54th Finance Committee meeting of the Indian Institute of Technology Roorkee held on 24th November 2023 at 3.30 P.M. in the Board Room.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the members in the 54th meeting of the Finance Committee.


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The agenda was then taken up.

Item No. 54.1: To confirm the minutes of the 53rd meeting of the Finance Committee held on 27.07.2023.

Since no comments were received, the circulated minutes of the 53rd meeting of the Finance Committee were confirmed.

Item No. 54.2: Actions taken report on the Minutes of the 53rd Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 27.07.2023.

The Finance Committee noted the actions taken on the minutes of the 53rd meeting of the Finance Committee.

Item No. 54.3: To consider the proposals as recommended by the B&WC in the meetings to be held on 23.11.2023.

The Finance Committee considered the recommendations of the B&WC, taken in the 48th meeting held on 23.11.2023 and recommended to the Board as follows:

Sl. No.	Item	Recommendations
1.	To consider and take an appropriate decision on the proposal for the construction of a Foot-over-Bridge (FOB) at Niti Nagar area.	Recommended to approve the proposal in principle at a projected outlay cost of Rs.3.5 cr. Further, asked to obtain first the necessary clearance for the construction of FOB from the relevant authority, and then to prepare the detailed cost estimates for consideration and approval.
2.	To consider and take an appropriate decision on the proposal for demolition of the D.S. Barrack building in the IIT Roorkee campus.	Noted that 122 years old D.S. Barrack is now structurally unsafe, beyond economically repairable and it is not a classified heritage building. Considered and recommended the proposal for demolition of this two story Building to the Board.

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3.	<p>To report the status, and consider the proposal for revision in the scope of work w.r.t. the work of Renovation, Facelifting, and Façade Lighting of the James Thomason Building.</p>	<p>The FC took a serious note of the deteriorating condition of the 176 years old James Thomason Building and the recommendations of the BWC in this regard. The FC also took a note of a recent incident of the roof collapse and expressed that nothing can be more important than the human life. The Finance Committee recommended the following recommendations made by the BWC to the Board:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Revision of the scope of the existing tender in order to include the structural strengthening and alterations for the structural safety also. The revised proposal should be presented for further necessary action. (ii) Construction of a new Administrative Building by according top priority. The earlier proposal in this regard may be revised both in terms of built up area/cost and location as per the current requirements. A proposal in this regard should be submitted immediately to the ministry for funding. (iii) Till the above materializes, IWD should undertake all necessary measures for the safety of the JT building namely propping, barricading, even part vacation after taking due technical advice. IWD should also carry out routine annual cleaning and other allied maintenance works frequently on the roof so that water doesn't accumulate.
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4.	To review and take an appropriate decision on the MoU between Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd. (PGCIL) and IIT Roorkee on “Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Energy”.	Took note of the status on MoU signed in year 2019 on “Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Energy” and recommend rescinding the MoU with PGCIL to the Board.
5.	To consider the proposal for modification of sanctioning powers related to the Institute Works Department.	Considered and recommended to the Board to change the delegated financial power to Dean (Infra) with respect to ‘Extra Items’, from the current 10% to 30% of contracted value of tender, subjected to maximum of Rs. 20 lac.

Item No.54.4:

To consider a revision of Travelling allowance to the newly appointed faculty from the organizations abroad.

The Finance Committee considered the item and recommended to revise the reimbursement ceiling of travelling allowance from 1.0 lac to 1.5 lac to the Board for the newly appointed faculty from the organizations abroad.

Further, the Finance Committee suggested that the proposal should be with actual statistics of such cases for consideration of precise revision.

Item No.54.5:

To consider the financial status of the Budget Heads OH-31, OH-35 and OH-36 and Budget Estimates for the F.Y. 2024-25.

The Finance Committee noted the financial status of F.Y. 2023-24 and considered the Budget Estimates of the Institute for the Financial Year 2024-25, given in **Appendix-A**. The Budget Estimates for F.Y. 2024-25 recommended to the Board for approval.

Further, the Finance Committee recommended to the Board that a case be strongly pursued with the Ministry to allot additional fund of Rs.29 cr. in OH-35 which were prior committed towards ongoing earlier approved critical infrastructure developments projects.

Item No.54.6: **To report the status of Audit Reports and Audit observations.**

The Finance Committee has taken a presentation on the status of Audit Report and Audit observations given at **Appendix-B**, and advised to take all steps to settle the draft paras at early.

Item No.54.7: **To report the status of loan availed under HEFA.**

The Finance Committee noted the status of loan availed under HEFA at **Appendix-C**.

Item No.54.8: **To report the status of pending advances.**

The Finance Committee has taken a presentation and noted the status of pending advances at **Appendix-D**.

The efforts in settling the long pending outstanding advances were appreciated.

Item No.54.9: **To consider the “Networking of Upcoming and existing Building” at IIT Roorkee and Saharanpur Campus.**

The Finance Committee considered and recommended the following proposals for a projected cost outlay of Rs.28 crores to the Board to approve in principle, to work out the details of each of these proposals along with budget estimates to consider and process for HEFA loan:
