Minutes of the 12th Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 30th July 2005 at 12.00 Noon in the Hotel Vasant Continental, New Delhi.

Communication regarding inability to attend the meeting was received from Prof. Ravi Bhushan, Professor-in-Charge Finance.

At the outset, the Director, Prof. Prem Vrat gave a brief introduction of Sri Jai Prakash Gaur, who was chairing the Meeting of the Finance Committee for the first time, and welcomed him as Chairman, Board of Governors of IIT Roorkee. All the members joined the Director in welcoming Sri Jai Prakash Gaur.

Before taking up the agenda, Sri Jai Prakash Gaur, Chairman, Board Of Governors stated that he felt privileged to be nominated by the Hon'ble President of India as Chairman, Board of Governors of this great Institute, which was also his alma-mater, and hoped that with the cooperation of all, the Institute would attain greater heights by bench marking itself with the best Institutes in the world. The Chairman then welcomed the members to the 12th Meeting of the Finance Committee, specially Mr. S.K. Ray, IAS, Financial Advisor (IFD), Department of Secondary and Higher Education, MHRD, New Delhi who was attending the meeting of the Finance Committee for the first time.

The agenda was then taken up.



Item No. 12.1: To confirm the minutes of the 11th Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 16th March 2005.

The minutes of the 11th meeting of the Finance Committee, held on 16th March 2005 were confirmed as circulated.

Item No. 12.2: Report of the actions taken on the minutes of the 11th Meeting of the Finance Committee held on 16th March 2005.

The position of action taken on the matters as reported, was noted.

Item No.12.3: Presentation by Professor-in-Charge (Planning) on the utilization and proposed expenditure of non-plan and plan funds, showing the details of projects in hand, projects in the pipe line, equipment procured and to be procured with the capital outlay involved in each case.

Prof. S.P. Gupta, Professor-in-Charge Planning, made a brief presentation before the Finance Committee on the Plan and Non-Plan Budget: 2005-2006. After the presentation, the Finance Committee observed that the information for the year 2004-05 should have been presented in the same style as given in the Balance Sheet for the year 2004-05. The same was noted for future compliance.

Item No. 12.4: To consider the matter related to revision of pay scales for the post of Programmer/ System Manager in respect of Dr. Jia Lal, Ex-System Manager, UOR.

The Finance Committee was of the opinion that the case has merit, and that the request of Dr. Jia Lal, former Programmer/System Manager in the University of Roorkee's Computer Centre, for granting him the payscales of a Lecturer/Reader, made vide his letters dated 10th June 2002 and 7th March 2005 (Appendix 'A'), should be accepted, and the said pay-scales given to him with effect from the respective dates on which the University Grants Commission had notified the staffing pattern and scales of pay for Computer Centres in the Universities. For the period during which the U.P. Government had not revised the System Manager's pay scale, the relevant revised pay scale be ascertained from



the IV Pay Commission's documents. Accordingly, Dr. Jia Lal's pay may be fixed as given at **Appendix 'B'**.

Item No.12.5: To select works staff at Saharanpur Campus on deputation from CPWD/PWD.

The Finance Committee accepted the proposal to obtain the services one Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil) and one Junior Engineer (Electrical) for the Saharanpur Campus, on deputation from the CPWD/other Central Government Engineering Organizations, initially for the period of one year.

Item No. 12.6: To consider the extension of the pay scale of Rs. 5500-9000 to the Assistants/Sr. Stenographers/Technical Assistants/Assistants (Personal).

Discussed and decided that the Ministry of Human Resource Development may be approached again with a request to allow the scale of Rs.5500-9000 to the Assistants/Sr. Stenographers/ Technical Assistants/Assistants (Personal) of IIT Roorkee in view of the fact that the same have not been withdrawn from the other IITs.

Item No. 12.7: Extension of the pay scales of Rs. 3200-4900 and 4500-7000 to the LDCs and UDCs, respectively.

Discussed and decided that the Ministry of Human Resource Development may be approached again with a request to allow the scale of Rs.3200-4900 and Rs.4500-7000 to the LDCs and UDCs, respectively of the IIT Roorkee in view of the fact that the same have not been withdrawn from the other IITs.

Item No. 12.8: To Provide for Nursing Allowance to the Nursing Staff and Patient Care Allowance to the Group 'C' & 'D' Non Ministerial staff of the Institute Hospital.

The Finance Committee recommended that Nursing Allowance @ Rs. 300/- p.m., be granted to the Nursing Staff of the Institute Hospital. This will came into force with immediate effect.

Item No. 12.9: To consider the proposal of Institute Librarian for filling up of existing vacancies of Group 'B' and 'D' in the Central Library.

The proposal of Institute Librarian for filling up of the existing vacancies of Group 'B' and 'D' in the Central Library is accepted. Arising out of discussions, it was emphasised that action should be taken well in advance to fill up those posts which are going to fall vacant in the Institute in the near future.

Item No. 12.10: To consider according Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction to the Preliminary Estimate for providing a Sub-station, DG Set and Lifts in the New Library Building amounting to Rs.80.00 lakhs as recommended by the Building & Works Committee.

The Finance Committee recommended that the Preliminary estimate amounting to Rs.80.00 lakhs as recommended by the Building & Works Committee for providing a Sub-station, DG Set and Lifts in the New Library Building as given at **Appendix 'C'** be approved.

Item No. 12.11: To consider according Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction to the Preliminary Estimate of Rs. 50.00 lakhs for Furniture and Furnishings of the Main Guest House as recommended by the Building & Works Committee.

The Finance Committee recommended that an amount of Rs.50.00 lakhs against the Preliminary Estimate of Rs.85.51 lakhs as given at **Appendix 'D'** and as recommended by the Building & Works Committee for furniture and furnishings of the Main Guest House be approved.

Item No. 12.12: To consider according Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction to the Preliminary Estimate of Rs.835.66 lakhs submitted by the CPWD for the construction of a New Boys' Hostel of 400 Seats capacity as recommended by the B&WC.



History:-: For construction of New Library Building at IIT Roorkee, there is administrative approval of Rs.12.00 Lac where in following provisions for electrical works have been kept.

(ii)	Air Conditioning	Rs.300.00 Lac
(iii)	Fire Alarm System	Rš. 13.50 Lac

The detailed estimate have been prepared by consultant M/s C.P.Kukreja & Associates. The likely completion cost of above services work out as under:-

- (iii) 4 Nos. Passenger Lifts.

It is not possible to provide above services out of the sanctioned estimate provisions.

The Institute Engineer, IIT Roorkee vide his No.E&W/1011/AEE(E) dated 10-1-2005 has desired preparation of separate estimate for above services so that approval of Building and Works committee is obtained.

Design & Scope: The library building is centrally air-conditioned and two screw type chilling units of 250 TR each are being proposed. Taking into account, light load and that of AHUs, pumps, cooling tower etc.and the starting current of chilling units, 2 Nos. Transformers of 630 KVA are required for library building.

The Institute Engineer, IIT, Roorkee vide No. Const./280/AEE(E), dated 20-2-2004 has desired to feed MBA building from library sub-station and suggested to increase the capacity of transformers from 2 x 630 KVA to 2 x 800 KVA. Accordingly it is proposed to install 2 Nos. Transformers of 800 KVA each. The Transformers are proposed to be dry type which are safe from fire safety angle and maintenance free.

IIT is proposing to interlink all the sub-stations through H.T.Cable network and ring main units for flexibility and reliability. As per the scheme prepared by IIT and received vide their letter dated 20-2-2004, it is proposed to provide 5 Panel H.T.Board at MBA sub-station. Normally 3 Panel H.T.Board would have been adequate. However to meet IIT's proposed requirement, it is proposed to provide 5 Panel HT Board in the library sub-station. The H.T.Panel will consist of Vaccum Circuit Breaker (VCB) which is latest in technology and widely used in such application. The fault level of 350 MVA has been selected. Relays will be provided for protection. Provision of metering and indication shall be kept in H.T.Panel.

For essential supply, DG Set is being proposed. Provision of L.T.Panel for non essential & essential load has been kept in the estimate. Adequate feeders will be provided for library building and MBA building. Spare feeders will be provided for extending to other loads and for maintenance also.

Provision of internal cable/bus duct inside the sub-station and L.T.Cable to library building has been kept. Provision of earthing & safety equipment has also been kept in the estimate.

In the event of normal supply failure, it is proposed to provide DG Set. The entire light, fans, computers, lift, water supply pump etc. are proposed to be connected on D.G.Set. Central air conditioning high side equipment are not proposed on D.G.Set. However AHU blowers are proposed to be connected on D.G.Set. Taking into account above load, the capacity of DG Set is proposed to be 250 KVA. The DG Set shall be AMF type and complete with acoustic enclosure etc.

In architectural drawings of Library Building prepared by the consultant M/s C.P.Kukreja & Associates, New Delhi, 4 Nos.lifts are proposed. It is proposed to provide 4 Nos. passenger lifts. The library will be used not only by students, but also old and sick persons. In addition the lifts will be used taking the books from one floor to other floor which will be required on daily basis.

Following provisions have been kept in this estimate.

- √(i) 5 Panel H.T.Board (As per scheme of IIT vide letter dated 20-2-2004)
- 2 x 800 KVA Transformer (As per requirement of IIT vide letter dated 20-2-(ii)س 2004)
- L.T.Panel for essential and non essential load. W(iii)
- Interconnecting cable between H.T.Panel, Transformer & L.T.Panel. U(iv)
 - (v) Outgoing cable to library building only.
