Strong academic background and demonstrated proficiency in quantitative analysis, financial modelling, econometrics, and statistical methods are desirable. Proficiency in programming/coding is mandatory, with strong hands-on experience in Python and R. A minimum of 18 months of relevant professional experience in roles such as Investment Research Analyst, Equity Research Analyst, Financial Analyst, Investment Analyst, Quantitative Research Analyst, or a closely related field is mandatory. The selected candidate will contribute to research in financial economics, investment research, financial markets, household finance, and economic and financial analysis, including collecting, cleaning, and analysing financial and economic datasets, conducting investment and quantitative research, developing financial and econometric models, performing statistical analysis, and translating complex financial and economic information into meaningful research insights. The candidate will be expected to independently use Python and R for data analysis, modelling, automation, and visualisation, and prepare research reports, analytical outputs, tables, charts, and research papers. The role may also involve analysis of equity markets, securities, investment decisions, portfolio-related data, financial performance, and macroeconomic indicators. Strong analytical ability, research aptitude, financial understanding, attention to detail, and the ability to work independently are essential. Efficiency in working with Latex is highly desirable.

12. Candidate shall bring along with them the original degree(s)/certificate(s) and experience certificate(s) at the time of interview for verification.

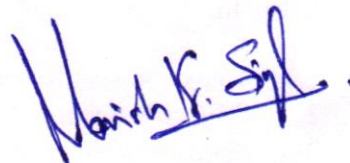
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13. Preference will be given to women and SC/ST candidates on equal qualifications and experience.

The interview details will be communicated to the shortlisted candidates after screening of application.



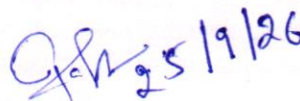

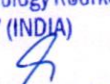
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
