INSTRUCTIONS

This award is given to the graduating students of B.Tech (Computer Science & Engineering) and B.Tech (Electronics & Communication Engineering), for the best B.Tech project at IIT Roorkee, based on its innovation, depth and potential impact. This award carries two gold medals (1 from E&C and 1 from CSE).

ELIGIBILITY

All graduating students of B.Tech (Computer Science & Engineering) and B.Tech (Electronics & Communication Engineering) having a minimum CGPA of 9.0 till the pre-final semester and with innovative potential deep-technical and impactful B.Tech project.

SELECTION PROCESS

The following procedure will be adopted to select the deserving student for this award:

- SCSP office will invite the application from the interested students at individual level. The applicants will be asked to submit a brief description of their B.Tech project based on innovation, technical depth and potential impact during their stay at IIT Roorkee. The applications must accompany supporting documents for the claims made.
- A committee will shortlist the applications received and conduct interview/presentation of the shortlisted candidates.

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

To apply for this award, the following documents are mandatory to submit:

- A brief write-up on why you deserve this award.
- Consent of other members if the nomination is made at individual level.
- Supporting documents indicating the title of project and details of student members along with brief summary of work done duly endorsed by faculty supervisor(s).
