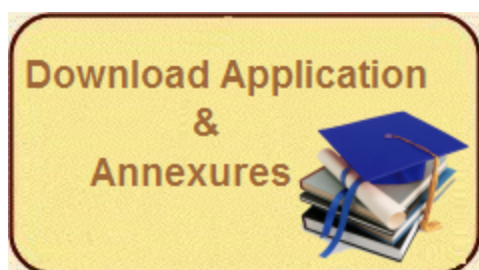

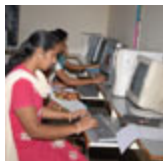


Giving Scholarships
