### SHOWCASING CREATIVITY, INSPIRING MINDS!





Towards the end of August 2024, our school conducted a series of impactful activities centered around Water Conservation.



Srishti Aswal won the 'Verbal Mention' award for her impressive delivery in the AIPPM where she represented Mallikarjun Kharge.


